Community Counseling Centers of Chicago (C4) is a leading provider of community-based mental health services and public education programs to more than 10,000 children, adults and families each year. Through the delivery of effective, empirically-supported mental health services, C4 provides people with the tools necessary to improve their health and the quality of their lives.

CHILDREN & FAMILY SERVICES Mental health experts provide individualized, child-centered and family-focused support services promoting the positive cognitive, social and emotional development of children and adolescents including:

- Screening, Assessment and Treatment Services
- Family and Group Therapies
- School and Community-Based Services
- Mental Health Juvenile Justice (MHJJ) Initiative
- Life Skills Training
- Therapeutic Youth Summer Camps

COUNSELING & SUPPORT SERVICES Through evidence-based/informed therapies and comprehensive community-based support services, C4 helps people develop better mental health self-management, coping and relapse prevention skills and connect with resources in the community. Services include:

- Therapy and Counseling
- Assertive Community Treatment
- Psycho-Social Rehabilitation
- Representative Payee
- Transition Services
- Vocational Rehabilitation

CRISIS SERVICES Crisis teams of mental health professionals provide crisis intervention services for children, adolescents and adults in severe psychiatric distress including:

- 24/7, 365 Emergency On-Call Services
- 24/7, 365 Screening Assessment and Support Services (SASS)
- 24/7, 365 Crisis Hotlines
- 30% of Cook County's crisis referrals for children & adolescents

PARTNERSHIPS Through a series of partnership initiatives developed with the Cook County Health and Hospitals System (CCHHS), C4 offers a growing number of programs and services to a wider reach, benefiting an ever increasing number of individuals within the community.

- **Behavioral Health Consortium (BHC)** A referral network of 6 behavioral health agencies, with a goal of streamlining access to behavioral healthcare services for CountyCare members. The consortium providers cover a wide geographical area across Chicago and suburban Cook County.
- **Cook County Community Triage Center (CTC)** A 24/7, 365 police drop-off and walk-in center for mental health crisis assessments, brief health screenings, referrals and case management. The CTC is located on the Southside of Chicago in the Roseland community.
- **The Learning Collaborative** with C4 as the lead agency, C4 and CountyCare work with several primary care providers and the Behavioral Health Consortium toward the goal of enhancing the behavioral health capacity of service delivery of all providers, as well as to strengthen care coordination and referral services for behavioral health.
- **Roseland Behavioral Health Clinic** An outpatient clinic in Chicago's South Side, offering individual, couples, family therapy, case management and psychiatric services.
- **Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT)** is a court-ordered behavioral health program supporting individuals with serious mental illness in Cook County. AOT enhances and coordinates services from a number of local and state partners and aims to reduce psychiatric hospitalizations, homelessness, incarcerations and interactions with the criminal justice system, while improving the health and social outcomes for individuals with serious mental illness.
