Community Counseling Centers of Chicago (C4) is a leading provider of community-based mental health services to nearly 7,000 children, adults and families each year. Through the delivery of effective, empirically-supported and trauma-informed mental health services, C4 provides people with the tools necessary to improve their health and the quality of their lives.

CHILDREN & FAMILY SERVICES Mental health experts provide individualized, child-centered and family-focused support services promoting the positive cognitive, social and emotional development of children and adolescents including:

PARTNERSHIPS Through a series of partnership initiatives devel-

- Behavioral Health Consortium (BHC) A referral network of 12 behavioral health agencies and hospitals, with a goal of streamlining access to behavioral healthcare services for CountyCare members. The consortium providers cover a wide geographical area across Chicago and suburban Cook County.
- The Behavioral Health Primary Care Integration Learning Collaborative with C4 as the lead agency, C4 and CountyCare work with several primary care providers and the Behavioral Health Consortium toward the goal of enhancing the behavioral health capacity of service delivery of all providers, as well as to strengthen care coordination and referral services for behavioral health.
- Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) is a court-ordered behavioral health program supporting individuals with serious mental illness in Cook County. AOT enhances and coordinates services from a number of local and state partners and aims to reduce psychiatric hospitalizations, homelessness, incarcerations and interactions with the criminal justice system, while improving the health and social outcomes for individuals with serious mental illness.

EDUCATION Youth Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) an 8hour public education course providing adults with the skills to identify, understand and respond to a young person ages 12-18 experiencing a mental health problem or crisis. For more information please email MHFA@c4chicago.org
